
The App Menu is a contextual navigation element for the user to easily switch between sections.

# START UP


## **Start Up**



When first opening the app or unauthenticated, the user will be brought to this screen that gives them the options to Login, Register for a Free Trial, or Skip.



### Log In




To log in the user will need to link their account to this device via a code generated.

Once they've done that, they will come back to this app, in which case would then bring the user to the home page of the app logged in.



# **Register for a Free 14-Day Trial**




It is recommended to at least include instructions on how the user can register for a trial in a web browser as it would be more convenient for them to sign up on a desktop/laptop/mobile than it is on the Xbox.

After filling out the form and clicking Register, a popup will appear with the Terms of Use and Privacy Policy. The user will have to select Agree to continue (next page).



## **Register for a Free 14-Day Trial Agree Terms**





The user can scroll left/right to view the entire Terms & Conditions, and press down to select the Go Back or I Agree buttons.






#### The Hub - Featured




This Featured hub section has a movie displayed at the top with a background image, description and quick View Details button. This movie can alternate. To browse other movies within Featured, the user can scroll downwards.

The background image has been scaled down to fit the peeks at the side to 1820x1024.





#### The Hub - Featured Scrolled




The user can scroll down to view all featured movies. Or click on the buttons on the right to Browse All or view Most Popular or Recently Added.





#### **The Hub - Trailers & Extras**



The idea for the Trailers & Extras hub section is to allow the user to easily watch clips and browse at the same time. They can toggle between this view and full screen of the video at any time.


The main video will auto-play.










The Originals section will take the same layout as the Featured.





#### **The Hub - Collections**




In the Collections hub section, there are two columns of Collections shown. The first 6 movies in each column will be shown here with a button to View All within that collection.






#### The Hub - Collections All




Clicking on the [...] button brings the user to a Long List view of all the movies in that collection.

There are controller shortcuts at the top and information about the movie at the bottom. Selecting the movie will bring them to the Movie Details page.




#### **The Hub - Live Channels**





All Live Channels will be mute until the user selects a channel.






# **The Hub - Live Channels Synopsis**




Selecting the Synopsis button brings up the description over the video player.






#### **The Hub - Live Channels Hover**




Hovering over a channel gives more metadata about what is currently playing.

When the user is unathenticated and does not have access to the Live Channels, they will be locked.



## The Hub - My Account




Scrolling to the left when landing on the Hub will take you to the My Account section.


The first screen has recommendations for the user which will change more appropriately as the app gets data from the user's interactions.

On the right, there are buttons to go to the user's Queue, History and Settings.






### The Hub - My Queue




Clicking on the My Queue button brings the user to a Long List view of all the movies in the user's queue.

There are controller shortcuts at the top and information about the movie at the bottom. Selecting the movie will bring them to the Movie Details page.




### The Hub - My History



Clicking on the My History button brings the user to a Long List view of all the movies in the user's history.



# Movie Details

#### **Movie Details - Overview**




The movie details landing page will have an image in the background, with the overview on the left with the major calls-to-actions and the sections (Trailers & Extras, Stills and Cast & Crew) stacked vertically.

The background image is 1920x1080. After this screen, for all Movie Detail pages, the background becomes blurred.



#### **Movie Details - Trailers & Extras**




Scrolling down reveals the Trailers & Extras.

The background blurs as the user scrolls downwards.

The user can either press on a Trailers & Extras video or the [...] button to bring them to view all Trailers & Extras or keep scrolling downwards to the next section.




#### **Movie Details - Stills**




Scrolling down reveals the Stills section.

The user can either press on a Stills image or the [...] button to bring them to view all Stills or keep scrolling downwards to the next section.



#### **Movie Details - Cast & Crew**




Scrolling down reveals the last section of the Movie Details - the Cast & Crew.

The Cast & Crew section is the focus where the user can press A to select it and then scroll left and right to view all cast members or scroll back upwards.

The arrows and the (1 of 2) text underneath only appears when there are more than 2 columns of names.




#### **Movie Details - Trailers & Extras All**



A movie's Trailer & Extras landing page looks and functions similarly to the hub's Trailer & Extras.



#### **Movie Details - Stills All**



Clicking the View More ellipses on the Stills takes the user to a Long List page with all the stills. Selecting an image takes the user to a full screen gallery of that image.

Stills behavior should be the same as the Xbox 360.



# **Movie Details - Stills Gallery Open**




The user can navigate the gallery by pressing the D-pad left and right buttons or press B to go back.



## All Movies

#### **All Movies**




The All Movies long list page will have all the movies listed out. The user can filter down to a specific genre with the Filter button on the left, which will bring up a pop up menu of the genres.

There are controller shortcuts at the top and information about the movie at the bottom. Selecting the movie will bring them to the Movie Details page.



#### **All Movies - Contextual Menu**




Since all Controller shortcuts require a Gestural shortcut as well, when the user has activated NUI, they can press on a movie to open up this contextual menu, which gives them the options of Going to the Details page, Playing the Movie right away, Adding the Movie to their Queue (or Remove), Pinning the Movie to the Home screen or Adding all movies in that list to the Queue.



# Video Player

## **Video Player**






This is the standard Xbox One video player with additional information about the movie at the top.

Movie information should come up only when the playback has been paused - not anytime the controls have been activated.



#### **Results**




The results will appear below and are scrollable vertically.


## **Settings**


## **Log Out**



Log In/Out will be shown as an overlay on top of the Settings page. The Log In text will be the same as in Start Up.




#### **Terms of Use**

## **Privacy Policy**




The Privacy Policy looks the same as the Terms of Use in the Start Up section except it is a new page, not an overlay. The user can scroll left and right to read or B to go back.






#### **Movie Detail**


There is no Trailers & Extras, Stills or Cast & Crew section. There is also no Pin to Home button here.
